
Sask Cup Series Points Regulations – REG-007

INTRODUCTION

The Sask Cup Series Points allows riders to accumulate points for their placings in sanctioned races to compete for the top male and top female riders in the provincial Sask Cup Series race events in each discipline (Road, Mountain Bike, Cyclocross, and BMX).

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to provide a summary of the regulations of the Saskatchewan Cycling Association (SCA). The SCA reserves the right to change these guidelines at any time.

The regulations contained herein ensure a well-documented, consistent approach to Sask Cup Series Points in Road, Mountain Bike, and Cyclocross calculations in Saskatchewan and will help to ensure that all participants are treated fairly.

SCOPE

These regulations apply to all provincial Sask Cup Series race events in Road, Mountain Bike, and Cyclocross held in Saskatchewan.

Any modifications made by the SCA to the *'Sask Cup Series Points Regulations'* will be used at provincial race events. Such provincial modifications may not apply at national or international races.

The SCA shall establish and maintain the Sask Cup Series Points standings for each discipline in the Sask Cup Series (Road, Mountain Bike, and Cyclocross).

Sask Cup Series Points Regulations apply to the following Sask Cup Series:

- Sask Cup Cyclocross Series
- Sask Cup Road Race Series
- Sask Cup Mountain Bike Series
- Sask Cup BMX Series Points and BMX District Series Points will be applied under separate regulations; *'BMX Race Day Wins and Series Points Regulations'*

POLICY OR PROCEDURE OR REGULATIONS

All Sask Cup races will follow the Cycling Canada Cyclisme' (CCC) or Union Cycliste Internationale / International Cycling Union (UCI) or SCA rules and regulations, including the regulations in this document.

All riders must hold a valid SCA Membership AND an In-Province or UCI license to be eligible to accumulate Sask Cup Series Points any race event, which is verified at Registration check-in.

No Sask Cup Series Points shall be awarded to a rider who competes in a race with a One Event Membership.

ADMINISTRATION

The SCA Summer Program Coordinator shall be responsible for the administration of the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations.

The SCA Technical Committee shall be responsible for the:

- Interpretation of any rule contained in the regulations
- Resolution of any dispute arising with respect to the regulations
- Amendment, addition, or removal of any regulations

Request to Resolve Dispute

Any SCA member may submit a request to the Technical Committee to resolve a dispute with respect to the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations and / or calculations.

Where a request to resolve a dispute with respect to the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations and / calculations has been submitted to the Technical Committee, the Technical Committee shall resolve such dispute in any manner it sees fit.

Request for Clarification of the Sask Cup Series Points

Any SCA member may submit a request to the Technical Committee for a clarification of the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations and / or calculations.

Where a request for clarification of the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations and / or calculations has been submitted to the Technical Committee, the Technical Committee shall provide a written clarification and may publish its written clarification in any manner it sees fit.

Relevant Considerations

For the purposes of carrying out its duties pursuant to administration of the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations, the Technical Committee may, in its absolute discretion, take into consideration:

- Past practice with respect to the administration of the Sask Cup Series Points
- Any other consideration which, in the opinion of the Technical Committee, is a relevant consideration with respect to the administration of the *'Sask Cup Series Points Regulations'*

Correction of Clerical Errors in the Sask Cup Series Points Standings

Notwithstanding anything in this PART, clerical errors, including, but not limited to, mathematical errors in the calculation of the Sask Cup Series Points standings may be corrected by the VP Technical, or by any person assigned the task of calculating the Sask Cup Series Points standings by the SCA.

Any SCA member alleging that a clerical error in the calculation of the Sask Cup Series Points standings has occurred, may forward a request to the VP Technical to review whether a clerical error has occurred.

Where a request has been sent to the VP Technical, or any person assigned the task of calculating the Sask Cup Series Points standings shall:

- Undertake to determine whether a clerical error has occurred
- Where a clerical error has occurred, make any necessary corrections to the Sask Cup Series Points standings

GENERAL SASK CUP SERIES POINTS RULES

Minimum of One Point Awarded for Completed Race

Every rider who completes a race in any Sask Cup Series race event shall receive a minimum of one (1) Sask Cup Series Point.

Award of Zero Points

A rider shall be awarded zero (0) Sask Cup Series Points for a race in any Sask Cup Series if:

- Rider receives a DNS (Did Not Start)
- Rider receives a DNF (Did Not Finish)
- For any other reason, the rider did not complete the race

Points Non-Transferable

Sask Cup Series Points awarded to a rider in a category, in any Sask Cup Series may not be transferred to any other category.

SASK CUP ROAD SERIES

See current [Road Race Regulations](#) for eligible categories that will be awarded points.

Sask Cup Series Points Awarded in Designated Category

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points for a race in the rider's designated category stated on the rider's Saskatchewan In-Province or UCI Race License.

Where a rider competes in a category different from the rider's designated category on their race license, the rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points in the category in which the rider competes.

Where a rider's designated category is combined with another category, or other categories in a race, and the rider competes in the combined category, a rider is awarded Sask Cup Series points for the race in the rider's designated category.

The Provincial 40K Individual Time Trial, Provincial 15 K Individual Time Trial, and Provincial Crit will not be included in the Sask Cup Point series.

You must start the Provincial Road Race to be named the Sask Cup Provincial Champion, but there will be no points awarded in the Sask Cup Series Points.

Sask Cup Road Series Points

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points based on the following tables:

Time Trial & Criterium

In a Road Race or Criterium, Sask Cup Series Points are awarded in equal shares to all riders who receive a pack time.

For the purposes of awarding Cup Series Points, the points awarded to a rider with a pack time are determined by dividing the total available Sask Cup Series Points for all riders receiving the pack time by the total number of riders receiving that pack time.

Any rider with a pack time who receives a separate placing from other riders receiving the same pack time is awarded a separate amount of Cup Series Points.

Points Where Tie in Time Trial

Where a tie cannot be broken in a Time Trial and, as a result, two or more riders receive the same time and the same placing, Sask Cup Series Points are awarded in accordance with the provisions for the calculation of Sask Cup Series Points.

Stage Race Sask Cup Series Points

In a Stage Race, Sask Cup Series Points are awarded to a rider for each stage completed by the rider.

Where a rider does not start every stage of a Stage Race, Sask Cup Series Points are awarded to the rider for each stage completed by the rider.

A rider's Sask Cup Series Points for a Stage Race are the total cumulative points awarded for all the stages.

SASK CUP MOUNTAIN BIKE SERIES

See current [Mountain Bike Race Regulations](#) for eligible categories that will be awarded points.

Sask Cup Series Points Awarded in Designated Category

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points for a race in the rider's designated category stated on the rider's Saskatchewan In-Province or UCI Race License.

Where a rider competes in a category different from the rider's designated category on their race license, the rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points in the category in which the rider competes.

Where a rider's designated category is combined with another category, or other categories in a race, and the rider competes in the combined category, a rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points for the race in the rider's designated category.

You must start the Provincial Mountain Bike Race to be named the Sask Cup Provincial Champion, but there will be no points awarded in the Sask Cup Series Points.

Sask Cup Mountain Bike Series Points

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series points based on the two hundred (200) point scale in the following table:

Stage Race Cup Series Points

In a Mountain Bike Stage Race, Sask Cup Series Points are only awarded for the Cross-Country (XC) stage.

SASK CUP CYCLOCROSS SERIES

See current [Cyclocross Race Regulations](#) for eligible categories that will be awarded points.

Sask Cup Series Points Awarded in Designated Category

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points for a race in the rider's designated category stated on the rider's Saskatchewan In-Province or UCI Race License.

Where a rider competes in a category different from the rider's designated category on their race license, the rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points in the category in which the rider competes.

Where a rider's designated category is combined with another category, or other categories in a race, and the rider competes in the combined category, a rider is awarded Sask Cup Series Points for the race in the rider's designated category.

You must start the Provincial Cyclocross Race to be named the Sask Cup Provincial Champion, but there will be no points awarded in the Sask Cup Series Points.

Sask Cup Cyclocross Series Points

A rider is awarded Sask Cup Series points based on the two hundred (200) point scale in the following table:

SASK CUP SERIES WINNERS

Sask Cup Series Points Winner is defined as either placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the eligible categories.

Winners receive a Gold, Silver, or Bronze medal.

A Sask Cup Series Points Winner shall be declared in each eligible category for all Sask Cup Series'.

A Sask Cup Series Points Winner in an eligible category in the Sask Cup Road Race Series is the rider with the highest total cumulative Sask Cup Series Points to be calculated by totaling each rider's Sask Cup Series Points based on each rider's **two (2) highest** scoring Sask Cup Road Series races; in the case of a Stage race, that event is consider one (1) start.

A Sask Cup Series Points Winner in an eligible category in the Sask Cup Mountain Bike Series is the rider with the highest total cumulative Sask Cup Series Points to be calculated by totaling each rider's Sask Cup Series Points based on each rider's **four (4) highest** scoring Sask Cup Mountain Bike Series races.

A Sask Cup Points Series Winner in an eligible category in the Sask Cup Cyclocross Series is the rider with the highest total cumulative Sask Cup Series Points to be calculated by totaling each rider's Cup Series Points based on each rider's **four (4) highest** scoring Sask Cup Cyclocross Series races.

In order that a rider may be declared a Sask Cup Series Points Winner, the rider must start a minimum of Sask Cup Series races:

- Two (2) Sask Cup Road Series races, or

- Three (3) Sask Cup Mountain Bike Series races, or
- Three (3) Sask Cup Cyclocross Series races
- In the case of a Stage race, that event is considered one (1) start

In the event of a tie with any medal placing in the Series (Gold, Silver, Bronze), the tiebreaker will be the higher placing at the Sask Cup Provincial Race in that discipline.

Sask Cup Series Points Winners MUST start Provincial Race in their discipline.

An Elite rider who does not start the Provincial race for any of the following reasons:

- The rider was selected to a National Team project
- The rider was competing in a Canada Cup, World Cup, or National Championship race is eligible to be declared the Series Winner, provided that a rider submits a written application for exemption to the VP Technical at least thirty (30) days in advance of the Provincial race

COMPLIANCE

Failure to comply with the Sask Cup Series Points Regulations may result in disciplinary action, up to and including loss of Sask Cup Series Points standings for that season.

Sask Cup Series Points standings may be revoked, if in the opinion of the Technical Committee, the rider does not respect the responsibilities and conditions as set out by the Sask Cup Points Series Regulations, and / or takes action considered contrary to the development of cycling in Saskatchewan.

CCC	Cycling Canada Cyclisme’.
Sask Cup Races	Series of SCA sanctioned Provincial races, culminating with the Grands and Championship races. Series points are awarded for achievement and upgrading. Medal and prizes may be awarded by the SCA. Clubs apply to host Sask Cup races and the schedule is determined by the SCA Technical Committee.
